- Fill out all the information completely.
- Answer the three questions on a separate sheet of paper.
- Number the trips you are applying for in order of your preference for those trips.
- Use a stapler to attach an envelope containing your \$100 deposit (cash or check made out to His House Christian Church.)
- Turn in completed application to connections area or church staff by Sunday, December 3.

How are Applications Considered?

Applications will be considered based on your answers to the questions on the form. Trip leaders will choose the people they think are the most compatible with their mission. If you are not able to go on your first choice trip, your application will be forwarded to your second choice trip's leaders and so on.
